Privacy notice

I. DEFINITIONS

The terms defined below in this Privacy Notice shall have the meaning attributed to them in this section:

Privacy Notice: This document.

Contest: A competitive process convened by the Antonio Gaudí Foundation, which will be valid from June 1, 2026 to July 15, 2026, through which any individual of legal age may register from any country as a Participant, to compete with their Photographs in order to be selected as a winner, in accordance with the terms and conditions established in the Contest rules.

Personal data: Any information concerning an identified or identifiable person. A person is considered identifiable when their identity can be determined directly or indirectly through any information.

Photograph: Original intellectual creation with which the Participant has decided to enter the Contest.

Fundation: Fundación Antonio Gaudí.

Participant: Natural person, of legal age, who is individually registered in the Contest..

GDPR: The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a European Union law that regulates how organizations process the personal data of EU citizens. The full name of the regulation is: Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

Website: Online platform that has been made available to the Participant as the sole means of registration for the Contest and through which Personal Data is collected, which can be accessed through the URL fundacionantoniogaudi.org

Holder: Person to whom the personal data corresponds.

Processing: Any operation or set of operations performed by manual or automated procedures applied to Personal Data, related to obtaining, using, recording, organizing, keeping, preparing, using, communicating, disseminating, storing, possessing, accessing, handling, using, disclosing, transferring or disposing of Personal Data.

III. PERSONAL DATA

The Personal Data that may be processed belongs to the following categories:

Contestant's Personal Data:

- Identification data: First and last name, pseudonym, date of birth, nationality, gender, and country of residence.
- Employment data: Name of the agency representing the contestant, name of the gallery representing the contestant, company name, profession.
- Contact data: Email address, telephone number, home address, website, Instagram profile, X profile, Facebook profile.

The Foundation may request copies of documents containing all or some of the aforementioned Personal Data.

IV. PURPOSES OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS

The Foundation will process Personal Data to the extent necessary for the specific purpose of considering you as a Contest Participant, adhering at all times to the principle of data minimization. Your data will be collected, processed, and stored on the servers of the Pictor platform owned by Pictor GmbH, which has the highest standards for its protection and safeguarding, which help to ensure operational security, investigate incidents, monitor the network, and provide assistance to the Participant.

Similarly, the Foundation may request and/or collect, through the Website, the Participant's Personal Data, for the purposes indicated in this section, as well as to comply with legal provisions that so require. The Foundation and/or any person in charge who may be involved in any phase of the Processing of Personal Data shall maintain confidentiality with respect to such data, in accordance with the applicable legal provisions.

The Personal Data that the Participant provides to the Foundation through the Website is used for the following purposes:

Purposes. These give rise to and are necessary for the existence of the legal relationship between the Foundation and the Participant, which consists of:

1. Creating the Participant's profile on the Website, to formalize their registration in the Contest, to notify the Participant of the status of their registration.
2. To inform Participants whether their Photographs have been selected, as well as to announce the winners of first, second, and third place, in addition to honorable mentions, and to coordinate and arrange logistics for the award ceremony.
3. Contacting the Participant by telephone, physical mail, email, SMS, and/or WhatsApp to provide them with information related to the Contest.
4. Identifying the Participant for the delivery of the Contest benefits and prizes.
5. Disseminating news, stories, and testimonials from the Participant in the Contest.
6. Send Participants information about the Contest that may be of interest to them.
7. Obtain, document, and publish testimonials regarding participation in the Contest related to the Foundation's principles of transparency and accountability.
8. Plan and manage the logistics of the Contest.
9. Verify and acknowledge authorship and rights.

V. PRIVACY AND CONSENT

In the case of adults, filling out the authorization form in this Privacy Notice implies full and unreserved consent for the processing of personal data. The Participant declares that they are of legal age on the date on which the data is provided and have full legal capacity.

VI. RECIPIENTS

The Foundation shares Personal Data exclusively with trusted recipients, when necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Notice.

We do not share your personal data with other countries or international organizations.

VII. RETENTION PERIOD

The Participant's Personal Data will be retained for the duration of the Contest and, subsequently, for a maximum period of 12 months in order to follow up on the announcement of the Contest winners and to comply with the obligations arising therefrom.

Once the applicable retention period has expired, your data will be securely deleted or, where appropriate, blocked, limiting its processing to the determination of possible liabilities, until the end of the limitation period for these.

VIII. MEANS OF EXERCISING RIGHTS AND REVOCATION OF CONSENT

Participants may request to exercise their rights to:

1. Access their Personal Data;
2. Rectify their Personal Data, when it is inaccurate or incomplete;
3. Deletion (right to be forgotten), when their Personal Data is no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which it was collected.
4. Limitation, the Participant shall have the right to obtain from the Foundation the limitation of the processing of their Personal Data.
5. Cancel their Personal Data, when it is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected;
6. Oppose the Processing of their Personal Data for legitimate reasons, and/or
7. Revoke their consent to the Processing of their Personal Data at any time, so that it is no longer used.
8. The portability of Personal Data.
9. To lodge a complaint with a Supervisory Authority.
10. To receive notification of any rectification, erasure of Personal Data, or restriction of processing carried out.

However, it is important for Participants to bear in mind that the Foundation will not always be able to comply with their request to cancel their Personal Data, oppose its Processing, or revoke their consent, as it may be required by law to continue processing their Personal Data.

The exercise of the aforementioned rights must be requested from the Foundation and must contain at least the following:

1. The name of the owner, address, and email address to communicate the response to their request;
2. Documents proving the identity or, where applicable, the legal representation of the owner of the Personal Data;
3. A clear and precise description of the Personal Data for which they seek to exercise any of the aforementioned rights (in the case of rectification, the modifications to be made must be indicated and documentation supporting their request must be provided);
4. Any other element or document that facilitates the location of the Personal Data.

IX. COOKIES AND WEB BEACONS

In order to improve the Participant's experience on the Website, the Foundation may use "cookies." For the purposes of this Privacy Notice, "cookies" are identified as text files containing information that a Website transfers to the hard drive of the Participant's computer in order to store certain records and preferences. The Foundation may use "cookies" to better understand the Participant's interaction with the Website and the services provided. The Website may allow third-party advertising or functions that send "cookies" to the Participant's computer. The use of "cookies" does not personally identify the Participant, only their computer.

"Web beacons" are images inserted into a web page or email that can be used to monitor a visitor's behavior, such as storing information about the Participant's IP address, browsing time, duration of interaction on the Website, sections consulted, web pages accessed prior to ours, and the type of browser used.

Participants may change their options through their computer and/or browser to stop accepting "cookies" and/or "web beacons" or to confirm whether or not they accept them.

X. DISCLAIMER

The Website may contain hyperlinks or hypertext "links", banners, pages, promotions, microsites, virtual stores, surveys, job boards, and other services, as well as buttons and/or search tools on the "World Wide Web" that lead to third-party websites. The Personal Data that the Participant may provide through such third-party sites is not covered by this Privacy Notice and its processing is not the responsibility of the Foundation. We recommend that the Participant verify the privacy notices displayed and applicable to these websites.

The Foundation warns the Participant that some links on the Website may include discussion forums, classified ads, chat rooms, among others, and that Personal Data disclosed through such means may in some cases be accessible to third parties. The Foundation shall not be liable for the use, publication, disclosure, and/or dissemination of Personal Data through such means. We recommend that Participants be careful and responsible with any personal information they provide on the internet.

XI. CHANGES TO THE PRIVACY NOTICE

The Foundation reserves the right to modify the content of this Privacy Notice at any time. Any changes to it will be communicated through the Website and/or the means of contact with the Participant.
